The Clubs away trip is still a work in progress but we are planning a two day trip on Tuesday 3rd + Wednesday 4th June, for a maximum of 25 Members.

Details of the itinerary will be circulated + placed on the website nearer the time.

At present the itinerary involves 3 visits:

PG Rix - Great Horwistley, near Colchester.

Big producers of onions, Carrots, parsnips + fruit. Farm 5000 acres + pack onions direct to supermarkets.

Peter Philpit MBE + Bartylands

Late lunch at Bartylands, tour around their farm diversification risks which include: Farm Park, Craft Village, Museum, Invergarden, Stables + education centre, followed by a visit to one of their farms - hosted by Chris Philpit, where they grow cereals, oil seed rape + potatoes. The family farm is total 12,000 acres.

Next day - travel back to Woodbridge to AW Morrier Farms 6,000 arable acres plus 1500 acres of heath + marshes. Largest UK grower of turnips, large employers of seasonal workers + have their own potato marketing Brand.
